This form also constitutes application for a graduate assistantship, which all applicants will automatically be considered for on the basis of the departmental criteria published on the Department of Linguistics webpage (see 'financial aid policy'). Students being offered an assistantship are notified at the earliest possible date; in the absence of such notification, students should assume that no assistantship is forthcoming and should seek support from other sources, including those referred to in the program description.

By submitting this application, you acknowledge and accept the following resolution, adopted by the members of the Council of Graduate Schools in the United States:

“Acceptance of an offer of financial aid (such as graduate scholarship, fellowship, traineeship, or assistantship” for the next academic year by an actual or prospective graduate student completes an agreement which both student and graduate school are expected to honor. In those instances in which the student accepts the offer before April 15 and subsequently desires to withdraw, the student may submit in writing a resignation of the appointment at any time through April 15. However, an acceptance given or left in force after April 15 commits the student not to accept another offer without first obtaining a written release from the institution to which a commitment has been made. Similarly, an offer by an institution after April 15 is conditional on presentation by the student of the written release from any previously accepted offer.”
